For clarification on any point not covered, please refer to the Master Points Handbook or the Master Points Secretary.

Any non-quarter fractions are rounded up to the next highest 1/4.

Constant reductions of $\frac{1}{2}$ per place to the top twelfth (receives $\frac{3}{4}$). Then equal blocks of $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ to the next twelfth of the field. Exception: if the top award is a whole number, or ends in $\frac{1}{2}$, then the place just above the twelfth point will receive 1 Green, in which case the next award should be $\frac{3}{4}$ as illustrated in the example below.

Example: 62 teams: top of 3 (62/24 is greater than $2\frac{1}{2}$): 11 bonus awards in all (62/6 is greater than 10). Awards are 1^{st} 3, 2^{nd} $2\frac{1}{2}$, 3^{rd} 2, 4^{th} $1\frac{1}{2}$, 5^{th} 1, 6^{th} $\frac{3}{4}$, 7^{th} - 8^{th} $\frac{1}{2}$, 9^{th} - 11^{th} $\frac{1}{4}$. If blocks are not of equal size, then the smaller sized blocks come first as per the example above.

Top sixth of the field have 100 of their locals converted into 1 green point, Second sixth of the field have 50 of their locals converted into 0.5 green point. Note: Last two pairs, of second sixth, get 0.5 greens and no locals.

If scored in sections.

Local points are given under Scale E - Basic National Scale.

Top sixth of each section have 50 of their locals converted into 0.5 green point. Second sixth of each section have 25 of their locals converted into 0.25 green point.

Note: Last pair, of second sixth, get 0.25 greens and no locals.

Main Final

Green awards based on the Total Original Entry.

Tertiary Final

Awards at Scale QE based on TOE equal to the formula T+(N/3), rounded down, where T = no. in Tertiary final and N the number of tables not qualifying for any final. e.g. TOE = 28, Main final is 7 tables, Secondary final is 7 tables, Tertiary final is 7 tables, there are 7 tables remaining.

TOE for Tertiary final is based on 7+(7/3) = 9

In all of the above, 0.25 greens will be given for winning 3x2 board matches or 2x3, 4 or 5 board matches, to be accumulated over the two rounds.

Tied matches count as a half win.

The number of wins is rounded down.

No Local points will be awarded.

In all sections, the winning team will receive 0.5 bonus greens in the Qualifying Round.

Main Final

Bonus greens will be given based on the Total Original Entry.

Top award is equal to <u>Tables</u> + <u>1</u>

Any non-quarter fractions are rounded up to the next highest 1/4.

Constant reductions of $\frac{1}{2}$ per place to the top $1/12^{th}$ (receives $\frac{3}{4}$). Then equal blocks of $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ to the next twelfth of the field. Exception: if the top award is a whole number, or ends in $\frac{1}{2}$, then the place just above the twelfth point will receive 1 Green, in which case the next award should be $\frac{3}{4}$ as illustrated in the example below.

Example: 62 teams: top award of 3 (62/24 is greater than $2\frac{1}{2}$); 11 bonus awards in all (62/6 is greater than 10). So: - 1st 3, 2nd 2¹/₂, 3rd 2, 4th 1¹/₂, 5th 1, 6th 3⁴/₄, 7th-8th $\frac{1}{2}$, 9th-11th $\frac{1}{4}$.

If blocks are not of equal size, then the smaller sized blocks come first as per the example above.

<u>PAIRS</u>

<u>Awards</u>

0.25 green point per match won or drawn, plus ranking awards to the top sixth of the field.

Top award is equal to $\frac{\text{Tables}}{24} + \frac{3}{4}$

Any non-quarter fractions are rounded up to the next highest 1/4.

Constant reductions of $\frac{1}{4}$ Green Point per place to the top twelfth of the field (receives 1 Green Point). Then equal blocks of $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, and $\frac{1}{4}$ to the next twelfth of the field.

Example: 62 tables = a top award of $3\frac{1}{2}$. (62/24 plus $\frac{3}{4}$ = 3.33, rounded up to 3.5)

If blocks are not of equal size, then the smaller sized blocks come first as per the example above for Swiss Teams.

Top award is equal to $\frac{\text{Tables}}{25} + \frac{3}{4}$

Any non-quarter fractions are rounded up to the next highest 1/4.

Constant reductions of $\frac{1}{4}$ Green Point per place to the top twelfth of the field (receives 1 Green Point). Then equal blocks of $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, and $\frac{1}{4}$ to the next twelfth of the field.

Example: 62 tables = a top award of $3\frac{1}{2}$. (62/24 plus $\frac{3}{4}$ = 3.33, rounded up to 3.5)

If blocks are not of equal size, then the smaller sized blocks come first as per the example above for Swiss Teams.
