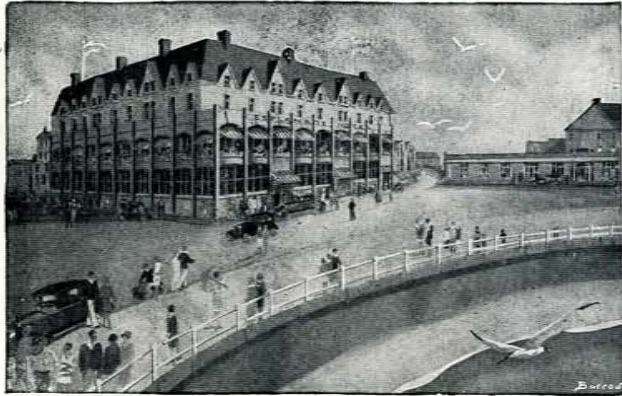

All are fine players, but the Welsh stars are also turning up in force and they take a lot of beating, as well I know.

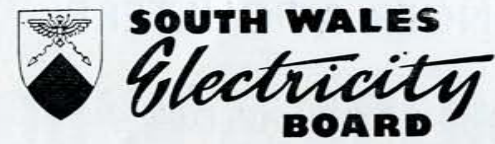
