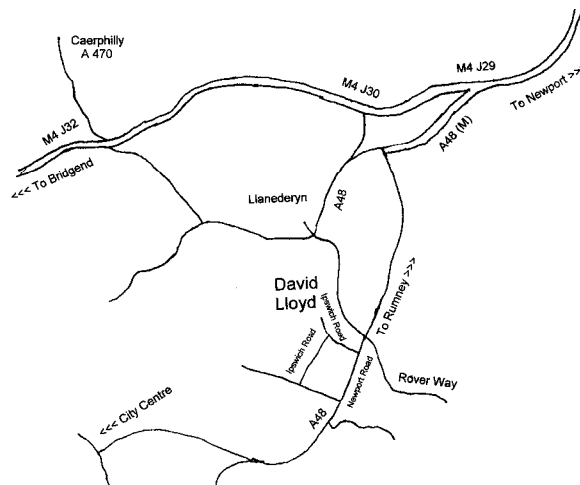

# Systems and Conventions

This is a level 4 event throughout.

## Seniors Qualification

To qualify as a senior, all players must be born before the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1952.

## Master Points

### Seniors' Pairs Qualifier

Local points to the top 1/3 of the field, National Scale E. The scales below are based on an original entry of 26+ tables and are for guidance only.

### Seniors' Pairs 'A' Final (if 7 Tables)

Winners 3 green points reducing to 14<sup>th</sup> place.

### Seniors' Pairs 'B' Final (if 7 Tables)

Winners 1.5 reducing to 14<sup>th</sup> place.

### IMP Pairs

Local points at National Scale E to the top third of the field.

### Seniors' Swiss Teams

0.25 green per match won or drawn, plus ranking awards to the top 1/3 of the field ranging from 3 to 0.25

### Swiss Pairs

0.25 green points per match won or drawn, plus ranking awards to the top one eighth of the field ranging from 3 to 0.25.

eg. 40 Tables: ranking awards to 10<sup>th</sup> place.

Note: Only one wine win per pair/team per event.
