Directions to Lysaghts

Travelling from the West. Exit M4 at Junction 28 and take the third exit off the 1st Roundabout onto the A48 East. Drive on, over the new bridge and exit left immediately down the slip road. Follow the signs.

Travelling from the East. Exit M4 at Junction 24 and take the first exit onto the A48 West. Drive on and exit left immediately after Carcraft. Follow the signs.

There will be cash prizes for leading teams, plus wine prizes (4 bottles per team) for teams with the highest IMP score on each round.

Master Points

0.25 green point per match won or drawn, plus ranking awards to the top third of the field. Master points are directly credited.
