WBU Open Trial 2011

Timing: Saturday 12:00-19:19, Sunday 10:00-17:19 (both weekends)

There will be a break of 41 minutes after 24 boards on each day and a gap of 11

minutes between the other pairs of matches.

Refreshments: Free coffee and squash will be available throughout. There will also be tea-making

facilities, which players can use if they have time without disrupting play. There will also be limited supplies of biscuits & fruit. Bring anything you wish to eat in the

break with you.

Format: 8 x 12 board rounds each weekend – with 48 boards each day and a sit out once on

the first weekend only. This will be a double round robin, the first round robin to conclude with the first match on the second weekend. The selectors reserve the

right to vary this and the associated timing should circumstances change.

Scoring: Butler removing two outermost scores. Imps converted to VPS using WBF scale.

Screens: Screens will be in use at all tables.

Slow Play: The time allowed for 12 boards is 94 minutes.

At about half way, and about 10 minutes before the end of play, the Director will announce the time remaining. Failure of the Director to meet this requirement will not absolve the players from penalty. At the end of the allocated time, the Director must impose, for any table still in play, a fine of 1VP for any delay up to five minutes, and an additional fine of 1VP for each further delay of five minutes or part thereof. A 1 VP fine will apply to each pair unless the Director considers only one pair to be at fault, in which case only the offending pair shall incur a 1VP fine. Where the same pair incurs a subsequent fine, the director shall automatically increase this by 50%.

Systems: The Camrose Series is a Category 1 event as defined within the WBF Systems Policy,

which is available at http://www.worldbridge.org/departments/systems/policy.asp
Thus Highly Unusual Methods (HUMs) are permissible in these trials, subject to 14

days notice, and preparation and distribution of suitable defences.

Smoking: No player may leave the playing area to smoke during a match.

Alcohol: Except with the permission of the director, no player may bring alcoholic beverages

into the playing area.

Broadcast: We expect BBO to broadcast the play at two tables on the second weekend, with

each pair playing to feature at least once.

System Card: All pairs will submit an up-to-date electronic version of their system card (preferably

in WBF format) to the WBU Chief Executive before the start. Any pairs playing brown sticker conventions should provide details of these and suggested defences thereto.
