WBU Lady Milne Trials

- Entries are now invited for the 2014 Lady Milne trial.
- Play will take place at the Metropole Hotel, Llandrindod Wells on Saturday 25 and Sunday 26 January 2014.
- The trial is to select pairs to play in the Lady Milne at the CityNorth Hotel, Gormanstown near Dublin in the Republic of Ireland on 11-13 April 2014, with the winning pair guaranteed selection.
- The trials will be held simultaneously with the Scottish Lady Milne Trials, with the two venues playing the same hands and scoring across both fields. This will increase the number of comparisons and result in a fairer competition. The Welsh results will be anonymous to the Scots and vice versa.
- The entry fee, which includes a light lunch on each day as well as tea and coffee in the other main session breaks, is £40 per person. Note that trials are now on a self-funding basis.
- Both members of the partnership need to be WBU members and eligible to represent Wales. Anyone seeking to play who has not already provided evidence of her eligibility to play for Wales needs to do so.
- Play will start on the Saturday at 11.30 and at 10.00 on the Sunday.
- The specially negotiated rate for players who wish to stay at the Metropole for dinner, bed and breakfast is £58 pp single, £48 pp shared twin/double. Players wishing to stay at the Metropole should contact Alan Screen (ascreen.bridge@sky.com) as soon as possible, in the first instance.
